3. **Body Worn Cameras (45 min.)**

Synopsis: At the June 4, 2020 Council Workshop, staff made a presentation on the potential incorporation of body-worn cameras (BWC's) in the police department. At that time, Council voted to begin preparation for the roll-out of BWC's (but with no appropriated funds) and directed the Manager to continue testing and evaluating preferred BWC systems and to come back at the January Workshop with a proposed path forward, in conjunction with a mid-FY21 budget review to assess funding options for BWC implementation.
4. **Mid-Year Budget Review (20 min.)**

Synopsis: As part of the FY21 budget, portions of the General Fund were isolated and set aside until a mid-year budget review occurred as budget safeguards against potential COVID-19 economic impact. Staff will outline revenue trends and projections for key revenue sources in the General Fund.
5. **DRAFT 2021 Legislative Agenda (30 min.)**
Resource: Mayor Pro Tem Dan Berry and Council member Aaron Wolff
Synopsis: In late 2020, Town Council designated Mayor Pro Tem Berry and Council member Wolff to work with the Town Manager and Town Attorney to develop a potential legislative agenda. A draft agenda has been developed for review and consideration by the full governing body that focuses on intergovernmental interests at the County, State, and Federal levels.
6. **Bennet Knoll Street Rename (15 min.)**

Synopsis: Staff is seeking direction on proposed road renaming of sections of Old Holly Springs-Apex Rd to Bennet Knoll PKWY and to Woodson Road and the entire length of Holly Springs New Hill Rd to New Hill Rd. Staff will outline the proposed road renaming, discuss name options and the timeline for renaming, and open a discussion on ZIP Code modification in the northwest area of Town.
